AWP to Present Four Free Author Events at Chicago Conference

Annual Conference Features Free Readings by the U.S. and U.K. Poets Laureate, Two National Book Award Winners, and Other Noted Novelists and Poets. Bookfair Open to Public on Saturday.

Fairfax, VA, January 15, 2012 — The Association of Writers & Writing Programs (AWP) will host its Annual Conference & Bookfair at Hilton Chicago and the Palmer House Hilton from February 29 to March 3, 2012. The conference is the single largest literary gathering in North America and will attract over 9,000 attendees. The conference will also bring together eight Pulitzer Prize-winning writers, two Poets Laureate, eight National Book Award winners, and nine recipients of the National Book Critics Circle Award, among hundreds of other readers, speakers, and panelists, and will feature 400 events, as well as exhibits by more than 550 presses, magazines, and literary arts organizations.
